Attendance



A bit of a disappointing week last week in terms of attendance, with an average attendance across the school of only 95%.

Attendance was particularly low in Reception classes, with none of the classes having an attendance above 95%. We strongly urge our parents to bring their child into school daily, even when they may be tired. It's obviously hard for such young children to move from part-time Nursery provision, or even no previous time in a Nursery environment, to full days at school, but it is essential that you get into daily routines so that they can settle as quickly as possible into school.

A large reason why attendance was so low was due to the fact that there were 37 days' worth of absences due to 'Leave in Term Time'. Had these children not been taken out of school in term time to travel abroad, then the attendance figure would have been 97.1% (an increase of 2.1%). It is important to note that some children really struggle both academically and socially when they have had a prolonged period out of school, and we discourage them from having this time out of school.
