Charging and Remissions Policy

Introduction

All education during school is free. We do not charge for any activity undertaken as part of the National Curriculum.

Voluntary Contributions

When organising school trips or visits, which enrich the curriculum and educational experience of the children, the school invites parents to contribute to the cost of the trip. All contributions are voluntary. If we do not receive sufficient voluntary contributions, we may cancel the trip.

If a trip goes ahead, it may include children whose parents have not paid any contribution. We do not treat these children any differently from any others.

If a trip has to be cancelled, a refund for that trip may be considered.

If a child is absent on the day of the trip, no refunds will be provided.

If a parent wishes their child to take part in a school trip or event, but is unwilling or unable to make a voluntary contribution, we do allow the child to participate fully in the trip or activity.

Details regarding the funding of trips can be provided on request.

Residential Visits

Generally speaking, due to the high costs involved in providing residential visits, there will be charges to parents/carers. Details regarding individual residential visits, and their costs, will be provided to parents/carers as and when they have been organised.

Breakfast and After School Clubs

There will be a charge of £3 per Half Term for after school club provision. This funding will be used to enable PE Staff to purchase any necessary equipment required to ensure that the club can be accessed appropriately.

Those children staying for the wraparound after school provision on Friday afternoon will be charged £20 per term per child, or a pro-rata amount if the child joins after the Half Term holidays. All payments made are non-refundable.

Breakfast club will be free of charge.
