Behaviour Policy 2022 Appendix 3

Stage	Action/Behaviour	Consequences/Sanctions
Stage 1	1 Dojo removed: - distract others - shout out - talk at the wrong time - not being on task 2 Dojos removed: - repeated incidents identified at Stage 1a - telling tales about others - make unkind remarks - not looking after school equipment - silly behaviour - inappropriate play	 -The child will be reminded that they have already had a warning, given another verbal explanation as to what they have done wrong and 1 dojo removed. -Another verbal explanation as to what they have done wrong and 1 dojo removed; the child will be asked to sit on the 'Thinking Spot' in their classroom, or separated from their peers in the dining hall or playground; a further dojo point will be removed. -If this behaviour continues, escalate to Stage 2.
Stage 2	5 Dojos removed:	 -The child will be escorted to their Year Group Leader (if it is during lesson time) or a member of the SLT for a period of 'time out'. The minutes of time out will reflect the age of the child. (Reception – 5; Year 1 – 6; Year 2 – 7). The child will take the timer with them in order to indicate the length of time. -Year 1 & 2 - 5 minutes of their next play time will be removed; Foundation Stage – 5 minutes of free-choice time taken from child. -The child will be asked to apologise in an appropriate way. -Any work not completed will be repeated until it meets the required standard. -Parents will be informed by the class teacher that the child's behaviour has led them to reach Stage 2 on the 'Consequences' list. -Year Group Leader/Senior Leadership Team member will add details of incidents onto CPOMS. -If a second incident occurs within a 5-day period that has led to a child being seen by the Year Group Leader, the Year Group Leader will ask to speak with the parents; the child will then be set up with a Low Focus Behaviour Plan lasting 2 days to see if the child can demonstrate an improvement in their behaviour. -If the child has been successful with the Low Focus Behaviour Plan, no further escalation will occur. -If the Low Focus Behaviour Plan has not been successful, escalate to Stage 3.
Stage 3	 All Dojos removed: repeated incidents identified at Stage 2 repeated and continued negative behaviour towards the same child racist or homophobic remarks extremely aggressive behaviour 	 - The child will be referred to the Deputy Head Teacher or Head Teacher. - All Dojos removed for the week. - 10 minutes of Lunch Time to be spent with the Deputy Head Teacher or Head Teacher. - The child's parents/carers will be contacted and invited into school to discuss the behaviour of their child - A Middle Focus Plan could be created. - The Learning Mentor will be involved. - If the Middle Focus Behaviour Plan has not been successful, the child will be moved to an Individual Educational Plan. Targets will be set in consultation with parents/carers and any relevant external agents.
