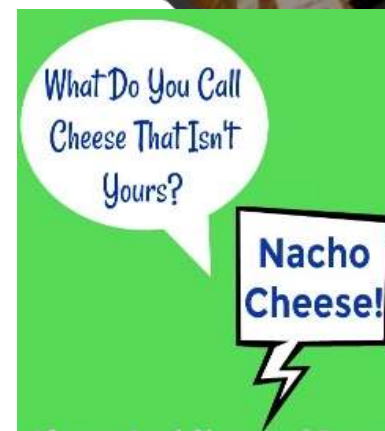
Jokes on Zoom
