Pre-stage Reminder given (in each session) when children first: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - distract others - shout out - talk at the wrong time - not being on task 	Stage 1a behaviour 1 Dojo point removed (once a reminder has already been given) <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - distract others - shout out - talk at the wrong time - not being on task 	Stage 1b behaviour: 2 dojo points removed <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - repeated incidents identified at Stage 1a - telling tales about others - make unkind remarks - not looking after school equipment - silly behaviour - not producing any work - inappropriate play 	Stage 2 behaviour: 5 dojos point removed <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - repeated incidents identified at Stage 1b - being disrespectful to staff - fighting - stealing - inappropriate language - hurting another person physically, verbally or emotionally on purpose 	Stage 3 behaviour: All dojos removed for that week Sent to SLT <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - repeated incidents identified at Stage 2 - repeated and continued negative behaviour towards the same child - racist or homophobic remarks - extremely aggressive behaviour
			Whole class consequences remove 1 dojo: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - not lining up nicely (including in the hall at lunchtime) - making a fuss when your class gets a visitor - travelling poorly around school - being too noisy - not tidying up the classroom
